Refugee Centers



Transportation with the of volunteers is possible, but only if the refugee themselves wish to use the volunteer services. In this case, the volunteer's credentials are thoroughly vetted by the police responsible for the security of the center. The presence of unregistered volunteers in the center is strictly prohibited. To enhance the security measures in place, photography and video filming inside the premises is allowed only to accredited journalists. These measures help ensure that the threat of human trafficking is almost non-existent at this location.

Jana Ⅲ Sobieskiego 5, Secondary School, Lubycza Królewska

This particular refugee center has been established in the school building and offers temporary housing to approximately 1,000 refugees, most of whom stay in the center for several days before dispersing to the rest of Europe by organized buses.





Refugee Centers



Aleja Sportiwa 8, Tomaszów Lubelski

The refugee center is located in the sports and recreation center in the town of Tomaszów Lubelski, situated approximately 22 km (18mi) from the Hrebenne border crossing. The center offers temporary housing to approximately 1000 refugees. Several security measures have been put in place to reduce the potential for human trafficking, including the prohibition of any unregistered volunteers operating at the center. Moreover, transportation out of the center is allowed

only via an organized network of buses or, alternatively, the relatives of the refugees. Taking pictures at the center is strictly prohibited and enforced by a constant detachment of police officers and employees at the center. Upon review of the noted measures in place, MOSFED staff concludes that the threat of human trafficking at this location has been significantly reduced.
